1 SAY

We're learning to  thank God for all he's done for us. One way we can show thanks is by helping others. We've been gathering school supplies for children who are in need. Let's put these supplies into kits now.



- 1** Have each Circle assemble one or more kits using the items children have brought.



- 2** Let children use paper and markers to create cards to include in the kits.
